All of us continue to be horrified by the events at the Boston Marathon. We have also been incredibly inspired by the actions of people who saved lives, gave comfort to terrified runners and spectators, and worked tirelessly to bring an end to this nightmarish situation.

All of us who have or have had an affiliation with TAC now have an important opportunity to help the individuals and families most affected by this tragedy. Many still have a very long journey ahead of them.

You may already know that Governor Deval Patrick and Mayor Tom Menino have announced the formation of The One Boston Fund specifically for this purpose. Goodwin Proctor, a Boston law firm, has volunteered to organize the fund and contributions have already been made by John Hancock, the Red Sox and Celtics, the Boston Foundation, and many other Boston-based organizations.

TAC will be contributing to The One Boston Fund and we are inviting current and former employees – as well as TAC colleagues – to join us in this effort. Over the next two weeks, all contributions submitted through TAC to The One Boston Fund will be matched by TAC – on a 1-1 basis – up to a total TAC contribution of \$2,500. TAC will be accepting contributions until May 7<sup>th</sup> and will send your contribution – along with TAC's matching contribution – to The One Boston Fund on May 9<sup>th</sup>.
