General Information

Workshop Registration

Q: How do I register for the workshop?

A: Registration links for each region have been embedded into the registration flyer. To register, click on the region of the workshop you'd like to attend. You will then be redirected to an Eventbrite page where you can complete your registration.

Q: How much do the workshops cost?

A: The workshops are **FREE**.

Q: Who is the intended audience?

A: Any staff engaged in working with families in their homes and other community-based settings.

Q: How many people from my provider site may register to attend the training?

A: Providers may register <u>as many staff as they would like</u> for the workshop in their region. However, registration is limited to 100 people per session.

Q: When should I register for the workshops?

A: The deadline for registering is <u>Monday, March 2, 2015</u>. Registration is first come, first serve and <u>space</u> <u>is limited at 100 people per session</u>. Therefore, registering early is <u>strongly encouraged</u>.
