Supportive Services for Veteran Families (SSVF)

Along with its partners, TAC is the lead firm in providing TA and support nationally for the SSVF program by delivering TA and training activities and materials, supporting best practices and standards, and providing policy guidance and implementation support to the VA SSVF Program Office.

HUD Vets@Home TA

TAC is one of five firms providing targeted technical assistance services to Continuums of Care (CoCs) that are committed to ending homelessness among veterans. Our focus is on helping communities to implement systemic approaches to ensure that homelessness among veterans is rare, brief, and non-recurring. TAC also supports HUD, the VA, and the United Sates Interagency Council on Homelessness by helping communities meet the federal criteria and benchmarks for achieving an end to homelessness among veterans.

Grant & Per Diem (GPD)

TAC helped the VA incorporate best practices into the design and implementation of its GPD program. Since that time, TAC has assisted GPD providers and their community stakeholders in planning and implementing modernization practices such as bridge housing and other promising models that support community-wide efforts to end homelessness among veterans.

HUD-VASH

TAC is able to combine its expertise in veterans' services with extensive experience in housing voucher programs. TAC tracks HUD-VASH awards and includes them in a one-of-a-kind searchable database on our website. We use this information to inform our work in the field with CoCs and veteran organizations.
